the HBC lifeline team that have agreed to give the surveys for extra

patients to complete surveys. The hospitals are also promoting this on		
their social media.

has been useful role for gathering feedback from Bridgewater on the		
issues of treatment rooms and the lack of community nurses.		
Healthwatch Halton has been asked to feedback on Bridgewater's EDS		
2022 assessment.
